

## CTE AGM 2019 to 2020. Treasurer's report.

We began the year with a balance of £709.92. In November, £ 40.00 was donated to the Royal British Legion, towards a poppy wreath to be given from CTE on remembrance Sunday.

The Christmas Carol service raised £370 for The Passage, and a lovely evening was had by all.

£226.69 was spent on the Lentwise course and despite lockdown halting the lent meetings prematurely, we managed to get £175.00 back from participants. This made a loss of £51.69, which was expected.

Every year, CTE have helped with the bucket collection for Christian Aid Week. This year, we haven't been able to do this, due to the virus and so we have sent them a donation of £50.00.

This leaves us with a balance of £568.23.
